Rotorua	Wednesday 21 st & Wednesday 28 th October



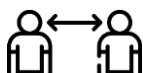
Health Questionnaire

Participants will be contacted prior to each session to complete a brief health questionnaire. Questions will relate to the general health of themselves and their households, as well as any potential exposure to COVID-19. Anyone who is unwell or has been exposed to the virus will be unable to attend the session. These questions will be asked again on arrival.



Hand Sanitiser

Will be available throughout each session.



Social distancing

Close contact will be kept to a minimum during each session.



Spotter/individual safety support person

Participants must bring someone to be their hands-on spotter at both sessions.



Contact tracing

A QR code will be available for participants to scan for their own records. We will use our attendees list for contact tracing purposes – we will also require the name and phone number of each spotter.
